

Aim

The Fellowships give promising young researchers from the Netherlands the opportunity to work for up to one year in an international top quality academic centre anywhere in the world to gather skills or knowledge that can consequently be applied in a Dutch academic centre.

Profile of the Fellowship candidate

- Proven quality and experience as a scientist in a Dutch academic centre;
- A (nearly) completed PhD or some years of research experience is preferred;
- Commitment to use the newly acquired skills and knowledge for at least 3 years back in the Netherlands.
- Available to present the Fellowship application to the 6th DCVA Translational Cardiovascular Research Meeting of the Netherlands Heart Institute on Thursday 23 June 2022 and Friday 24 June 2022
- Candidate has the support of the head of the Cardiology department of one of the Dutch University Medical Centres.

Financing, criteria

The Netherlands Heart Institute can facilitate Fellowships from 4 to 12 months. The maximum funding per month is 4.000 Euro's.

5% of the budget should be allocated for 'open science' meaning for example but not limited to: open access publication fees, open data repositories and data sharing based on the FAIR principles (Findable (F), Interoperable (I), Accessible (A) and Reusable (R)).

In case of preclinical trials, protocols need to be registered at www.preclinicaltrials.eu

In case you want to visit the US or Canada, you need to allocate 1.500 Euro's for extra insurances, to be taken out by NLHI.

Procedure

Send your application to the Netherlands Heart Institute via info@heart-institute.nl no later than **Monday May 2nd 2022, 12:00h CET**

Your application will need to consist of (all documents in English):

- An updated CV including a list of the most relevant publications;
- A high resolution digital passport photo of yourself;
- A research plan and a budget for your time abroad (not too long, about 5 A4 pages);
- A 200 word abstract of your research plan for our website in English and in Dutch;
- A letter of support from the institution where you will do your Fellowship;
- A letter of support of the head of the Cardiology department of one Dutch University Medical Centres;

6th Translational Cardiovascular Research Meeting

Up to 3 candidates of sufficient quality will be invited to present their application during the Congress of the Netherlands Heart Institute. If there are more than 3 applications of sufficient quality, the board of the Netherlands Heart Institute will select 3 candidates.

During the congress a public vote will decide who is granted the fellowship. The awarding session will be during the closing session on Friday.
